### SEMINAR AND LEADERSHIP TRAINING IN ARMENIA 14<sup>th</sup> -16<sup>th</sup> OF AUGUST 2009

**Leadership training** includes having fun and learning new things. It is open for young scouts and jungschars aged from 16 to 20 years. LT includes an overnight hike and lots of other activities together with new YMCA friends.

**Seminar** is for those older than 20 years. Traditionally part of the seminar programme includes sharing experiences on scouting and jungschar work in different countries. Also the annual meeting of ESG takes place during the seminar. There is one seat available in executive committee. Those interested in joining executive committee can contact Heidi already before the seminar.

Seminar and LT are great opportunities for young and older participants to get connected with other YMCA scouts and jungshars from all over the Europe. New friends are guaranteed!

This year seminar and LT take place from Friday to Sunday. After the formal programme you can take part to sightseeing tour in Yerevan for two more days. Travelling to Armenia is an adventure for most of us – we highly recommend spending some extra nights.

#### Participation fees

150 euros for western participants  
100 euros for eastern participants

Fees include transportation from Yerevan to our camping site and back, staying at the camping site for two nights and three meals per day. Fees are paid in cash when arriving to camping site. If you are unaware of how high your fee is, please don't hesitate to ask.

#### Sightseeing

Sightseeing costs 60 euros extra. It includes hostels for two nights in Yerevan, and it's the cheapest possible price. You are of course welcome to book your own accommodation, if you want to get a better one.

#### Travelling to Armenia

Take a flight to Yerevan international airport. Reserve your flights so that you arrive in Yerevan before 12 am on friday. This way we can easily arrange the common transportation to the camp site.



## Armenian Visa
